

THE COCKADOO BAR & RESTAURANT PRIVACY POLICY

This privacy policy sets out how Cockadoo (cockadoo.co.uk) uses and protects any information that you supply when you use this website.

PRIVACY & SECURITY

We take security and privacy policy issues seriously, and are committed to ensuring that your privacy is protected. Should we ask you to provide certain information by which you can be identified when using this website, then you can be assured that it will only be used in accordance with this privacy statement. The following policy sets out how we collect and use personal and other data through Cockadoo.co.uk (the 'Website').

GENERAL USE OF THE WEBSITE

We shall not ask you to supply any personal data as a condition of your use of the Website. We will only ask for personal data if you choose to purchase products advertised on the Website, where it is necessary for you to provide your name, contact and payment details.

We may use cookies whilst you use the Website to monitor your use of the Website. This will enable us to improve the information we present to you. Use of a cookie is not linked to any personal identifying information, and once you close your browser, the cookie terminates. We will also use your Internet protocol ("IP") address to analyse usage trends on the Website and to administer it. Again, IP addresses are not linked to personally identifiable information. If you do not wish to permit us to use cookies, you are free at any time to disable the use of cookies by means of your Internet browser software. Please note, however, that disabling cookies will affect certain functions of the Website, including the ordering and payment functions. While you will continue to be able to browse the Website, unfortunately you will not be able to make purchases on the Website.

USE OF REGISTERED USERS' DATA

If you are a registered user of the Website, we shall use that profile in order to set permissions for your use of the Website and to provide you with the information services you request as part of the registration process. Your registered user name may also be used to identify all messages, posts or other interactive content you submit to the Website. We may use cookies whilst you use our forums, blogs, wikis and other interactive channels. This will enable us to improve the information we present to you and your user experience of the Website interactive services. Once you close your browser, the cookie terminates.

We will also use your IP address to analyse usage trends and to administer your use of the Website. Although the use of a cookie and your IP address is not linked to any personal identifying information, the Website administrators will report on the use of our interactive services using information obtained through our use of cookies. We shall also be able to ensure that registered users cannot falsely attribute messages, posts or other interactive content to other registered users.

PERSONAL DATA

To enable us to register you for use of the Website (and to create your personal profile) and accept your orders on the Website, we need to collect and use personal data about you (your "Personal Information"). The Personal Information is all the information requested on any online order form. We shall keep your Personal Information secure and confidential, and in accordance with this Security and Privacy Policy. We warrant that any party under our control processing personal data holds and will maintain a notification with the Information Commissioner under the Data Protection Act 1998, as amended or re-enacted from time to time, for all processing of your Personal Information. We shall not disclose or share your Personal Information to or with any third party without your consent, other than disclosure to each of us and our payment agent for the purpose of facilitating payments and to other trusted third parties for their and our provision of information that we and they consider that you may find interesting, where you have given us permission to do so.

All Personal Information that you provide to us is stored on our secure servers. Any payment transactions will be encrypted and is not, in any event, held on our servers. Where we have given you (or where you have selected) a password that enables you to access the Website, you are responsible for keeping this password confidential. Please do not share your password with any other person. Please note that the transmission of personal data via the Internet is not completely secure. We recognise the importance of security when information is being passed over the Internet and maintain high standards of security. However, while we will do our best to ensure that your Personal Information is protected, we cannot guarantee the security of the Personal Information that is transmitted to the Website; transmission is therefore at your own risk.

You have the right to ask us not to process your personal data for marketing purposes. We will usually inform you (before collecting your data) if we intend to use your data for such purposes or if we intend to disclose your information to any third party for such purposes.
